Early voting will be from May 14 to 18 at: Any of the early voting locations in Tarrant County, including the Northwest Sub-Courthouse, White Settlement Public Library, B.J. Clark Center in Azle and the Eagle Mountain Saginaw ISD office. **Election Day itself is May 22nd.**
