BE IT REMEMBERED, at a regular meeting of Commissioners' Court of Dallas County, Texas held on the 5th day of May, 2020, on a motion made by John Wiley Price, Commissioner District No.3, and seconded by _____, the following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, over 1 million persons in the United States has been diagnosed with COVID-19 and over 61,000 Americans have died from the disease, and

WHEREAS, over 27,000 Texans have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and over 700 have died from the disease, and

WHEREAS, over 3,200 persons in Dallas County have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and over 90 have died from the disease, and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 remains a threat to the health and safety of persons in Dallas County, Texas and around the World, and

WHEREAS, State District Court Judge Tim Sulak ruled on April 17, 2020 that a Texas voter without established immunity to COVID-19 who wished to vote in any 2020 election has the right to vote by mail as long as the virus that causes COVID-19 is in general circulation.

THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that a Dallas County voter who wants to vote by mail can send an application for ballot by mail to Dallas County Elections, check the box on the application indicating "Disability" as the reason for voting by mail, and the elections division will process that application as normal.
